The institution facilitates confidential reporting through an online grievance portal and supports students with counselling services and awareness programs, fostering a safe and inclusive learning environment.

Zero Tolerance Against Anti-Ragging

THE ANTI-RAGGING CELL AT QUANTUM UNIVERSITY

1. Quantum University campus is ragging free and zero tolerance to ragging. To ensure the implementation of anti-ragging directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, Govt. of India, an anti-ragging squad and Proctorial Board is well constituted as per UGC norms and Hon'ble Supreme Court, Govt. of India guidelines to maintain strict discipline in campus in all aspects.
2. Formation of anti-ragging committee is defined. Discipline committee (Proctorial Board) is working as a support center. Discipline Committee (Proctorial Board) and Internal Complaints Committee will support the anti-ragging committee.
3. To ensure prompt response as per UGC norms and Hon'ble Supreme Court, Govt. of India, an anti-ragging control room is maintained in campus, with all the necessary facilities.

ANTI RAGGING POLICY

Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging

Ragging is a Criminal Offence as per the Supreme Court verdict. Ragging is an offence under Penal Code and under Section 116 which defines as: "Causing, inducing, compelling or forcing a student, whether by way of practical joke or otherwise, to do any act which detracts from human dignity or violates his/ her person or exposes him/ her to ridicule from doing any lawful act. By intimidating, wrongfully restraining, wrongfully confining, or injuring him or by using criminal force on him/her or by holding out to him/her any threat of intimidation, wrongful confinement, injury or the use of criminal force." "Ragging in all its forms is totally banned in this University including in its departments, constituent units, all its premises (Academic, Residential, Sports, Kiosks, Cafeteria & the like) whether located within the campus or outside and in all means of transportation of students whether public or private. The University shall take strict action including but not limited to criminal proceeding and/or cancellation of admission against those found guilty of ragging and/or of abetting ragging and the burden of proof shall hereby lie on the perpetrator of alleged ragging and not on the victim. An offence of ragging may be charged either on a written complaint by the affected or on independent findings of the Anti Ragging Squad. The University is bound by the U.G.C. Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009."




Formation of the Committee

The Anti-Ragging Committee at Quantum University is comprised of a Convener, Co Convener, faculty members and hostel wardens. This diverse team collaborates to enforce a strict anti-ragging policy, investigate incidents, and conduct awareness programs to ensure a safe and respectful campus environment.

Anti Ragging Committee Meeting

The Anti-Ragging Committee at Quantum University convenes regular meetings to review incidents, analyze the effectiveness of preventive measures, discuss policy compliance, strategize for awareness campaigns, and coordinate with other committees. These meetings serve as a crucial platform for communication, feedback, and continuous improvement, contributing to the committee's proactive efforts to maintain a safe and respectful campus environment.

The following points were discussed in the meeting:

- (1) To ensure the monitoring of incidents of student ragging within the campus.
- (2) To raise awareness and educate incoming students about the serious repercussions of ragging.
- (3) The anti-ragging team should carry out unannounced inspections of the hostel, cafeteria, and other student gathering areas at least once during the initial three months after the admission of a new class, until further instructions.
- (4) To enhance security measures in high-risk areas such as hostel, cafeteria, gymnasium, library, and dining hall. Assigning night duties and floor responsibilities to both ACR and non-ACR members respectively.
- (5) All department heads/coordination should deliver talks on ragging to their respective classes during orientation programs and the initial few sessions.
- (6) If parents witness any incidents of extreme violence, they should promptly notify the college administration.

- (7) All senior and junior students must sign the undertaking on the UAC anti-ragging website.
- (8) Organization of campus ambassador's formation to take place in the campus.
- (9) Students should be provided with a student handbook and joining prescription to familiarize themselves with campus operations prior to their arrival.

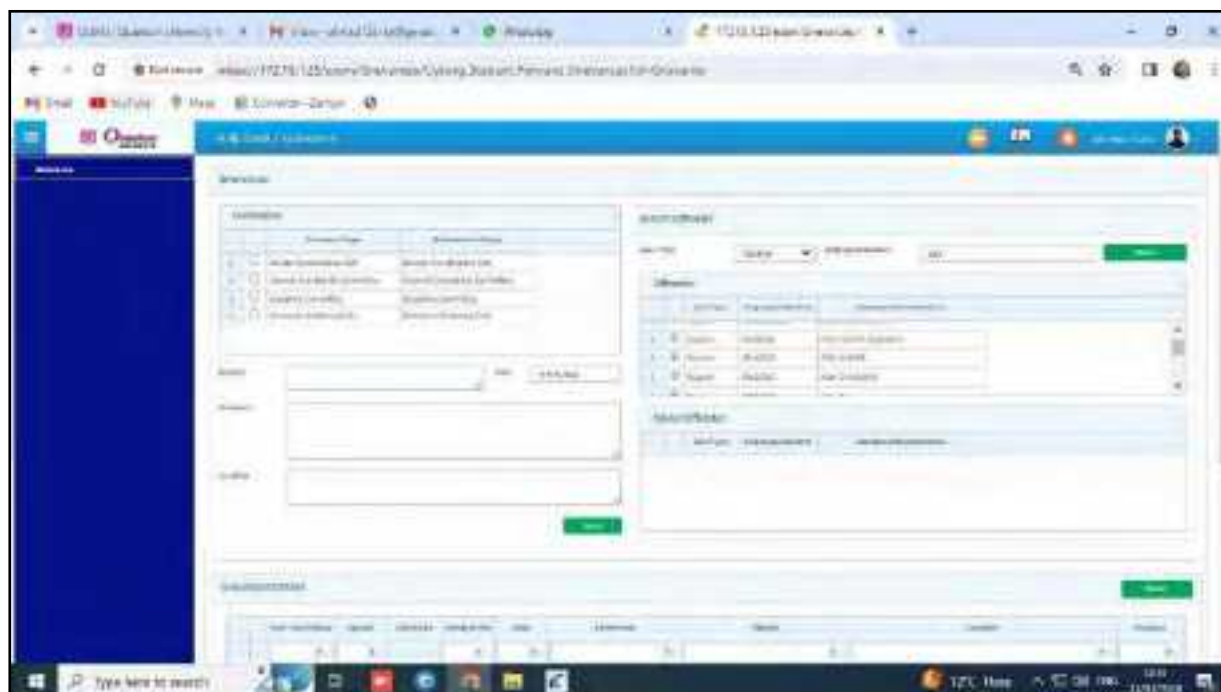

The Grievance Redressal Cell at Quantum University serves the following key purposes:

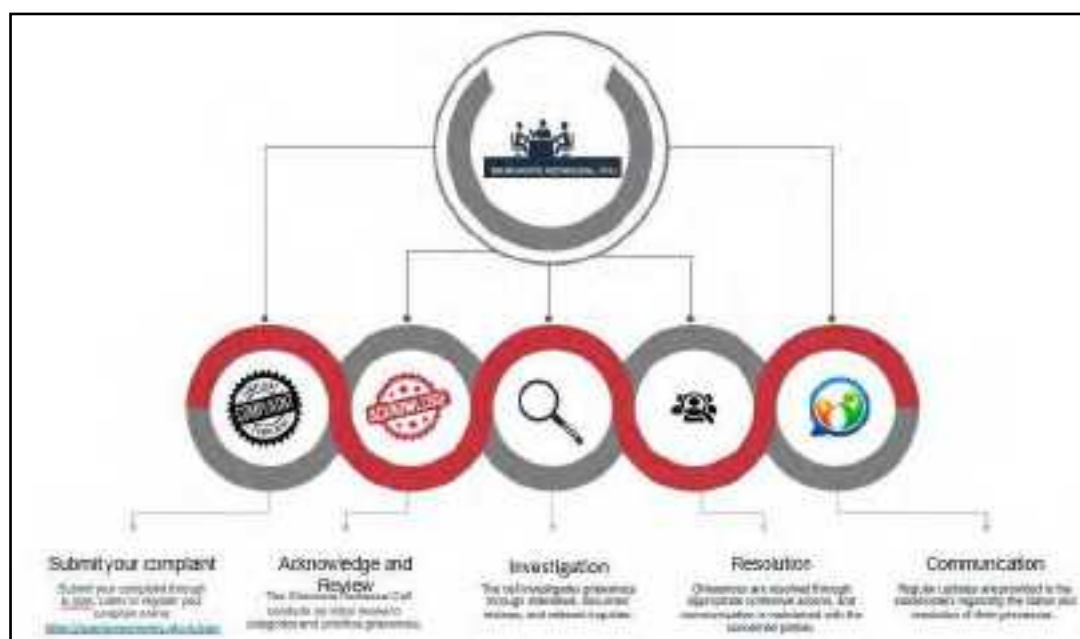
Grievance Handling: Receives and addresses grievances from students, faculty, staff, and other stakeholders.

Promotion of Transparency: Promotes transparency by communicating grievance resolution procedures to the university community.

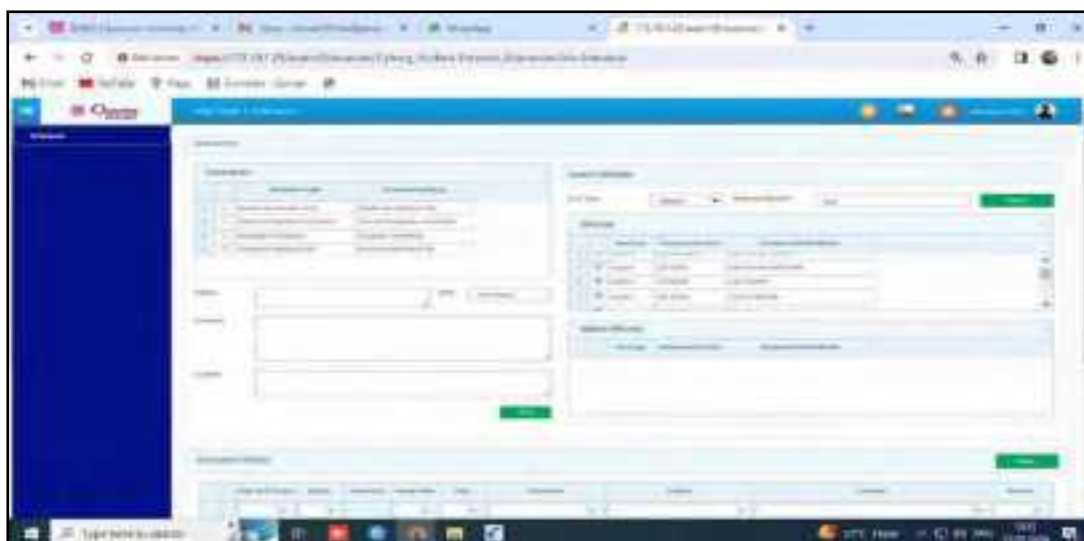
