In the current semester, 11 activities focused on life skills and soft skills were successfully conducted, contributing to the overall development of student capabilities.

4. Value-Added Courses and Certification Programs

Resolution: It was resolved to introduce value-added courses on emerging technologies. Each department will collaborate with industry experts to identify relevant courses and ensure the programs are aligned with current trends.

A total of 31 VAC programs were conducted, with 1,693 students enrolled. Out of these, 1,268 students successfully completed the programs and received their certificates.

5. Placement Cell Activities, Including Resume-Building and Skill Development Workshops

9. Feedback Collection and Analysis for the Previous Semester

Resolution: The feedback from students and faculty revealed overall satisfaction, with some

areas for improvement. It was resolved that departments will address the highlighted issues and make necessary improvements in course content delivery and others.

10. Planning for an Industry-Academia Joint Activities

Resolution: It was resolved to organize an industry-academia joint activities by, inviting key industry leaders and academic experts to foster collaboration and bridge the gap between academia and industry expectations.

Several guest lectures and webinars were conducted featuring key industry leaders and academic experts.

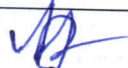
